

How do I submit my COVID test prior to move-in?

- 1) Get your COVID test within 7 days of your move-in date on September 12th (home COVID tests will not be accepted). (September 5th -9th ideally)
- 2) Log in to your MyWesternHealth patient portal and go to "Medical Clearances".
- 3) Click "Update" next to the "COVID-19 Test requirement".
- 4) Enter the collection date of your COVID test (not the date of your result).
- 5) Upload a copy of your COVID test.
- 6) Click "Done". Your status will show compliant as soon as it is verified.

What happens if my COVID test is positive?

Do NOT move into university housing. Isolate at home for 10 days before coming to campus. Make sure to upload the results as noted above. Housing staff will contact you for further instructions. Note: If you are unable to isolate at home, Western will make arrangements for you to isolate on campus.

What if I had a previous positive COVID test in the past?

If you have received a positive COVID test within 90 days of your move in date and have recovered, simply upload a copy of that positive result. You will not need to re-test prior to move in.

Do I have to submit another test result 1-7 days before I move into the dorms on campus?

No, the test results you submit before moving into the Shannon Point dorms will serve to clear you for moving into your main campus housing as well.
